French-Armenian daily school project in Valence: the community gives its green light



Members of the Armenian Apostolic Church parish of Valence, France, agreed to carry out the French-Armenian daily school project. This approval is the starting point for a major project in Valence.

The school will be located in the complex adjacent to the church, at rue de la Cécile. The premises at the heart of the city have great potential. The land has enough space to build a parking lot (drop off parking) and a spacious playground. Significant renovations and extension works are anticipated in order to respect the standards and norms of the *Education Nationale* (French Education Ministry).

Four pedagogical axes will guide the project: the transmission of Armenian language and culture, excellence in teaching, French-Armenian-English multilingualism, and an exemplary identity balance between French and Armenian cultures.

This program gives a prevailing space to the child development and can only succeed if the student can learn in the best possible conditions.

As such, consultations were held with architects and building professionals. The cost of operations is estimated at more than € 1.5 million.

A call for donations will start on October 2017. The participation of all Armenians, in France and abroad, is essential in order to start the construction work. This fundraising is necessary to carry out this project, and our generous benefactor, Kevork Arabian, has decided to give it a huge boost with 600,000 euros.
